

n After only three seasons of excavation, the Valley
of the Golden Mummies in the Bahariya Oasis of Egypt
is proving to be one of the richest sources of artifacts
and information yet encountered in a country that is famous
for its mummies.

n Even though only a handful of tombs have been opened so far, archeologist Zahi Hawass and his colleagues have already discovered 234 mummies, many of them sheathed in gold, others covered by finely painted, delicate masks n n n
